GLOBAL EDUCATION COMES TO GUWAHATI

A new era of education has begun in Guwahati with the opening of The Cambridge **School**, the first international school in the region.

he Cambridge School, Guwahati [TCSG], affiliated to the University of Cambridge International Examinations, UK, has brought in a new era of education to north east in being, till date, the first and the only international school in that region to offer the coveted IGCSE 'O' and 'A' level qualifications. The school, established in 2010, has come a long way in propagating its main philosophy of 'inspiring and empowering its students to be lifelong learners, critical thinkers and productive members of an everchanging global society'. Now in its fourth year, TCSG continues to move forward in the true spirit of ability driven education while sensitising its students to the needs of the community, besides inculcating values like integrity, fortitude and acceptance of individual differences. In the words of the school Principal Dr.P.Bhattacharyya, 'The school offers an academic program that facilitates an overall development of the human personality in all its dimensionsintellectual, physical, social, moral and spiritual'.

TCSG has rapidly progressed in all aspects in establishing itself as one of

the leading schools of the region, and consequently it was ranked 25th among the 'Top 30 Schools of the Country' as per a survey conducted by this very newspaper in 2012.

What is notable about this school is that in spite of admitting only day scholars on its rolls, it has not confined its responsibility to propagation of quality education alone. It is the only school in the region to have devoted an entire day every week to extracurricular activities that include training in music, dance, sports and aesthetics. Domestic and international student

exchange programmes as well as visits to places like NASA are an integral part of the learning process for students. Mr.Vikas Kumar Jain, whose child studies in Class V in this school comments: 'We are glad to find a school of international standards. It is one of the best schools for all round development of children. Teachers pay very good attention to each child'. Another parent, Mrs. Manisha Baruah says: 'I am very happy with the school. Introduction of remedial classes,



school trips etc. have given a personal boost to the students. Hard working teachers are an asset'.

Located in its sprawling premises in Sarusajai, Guwahati, TCSG attributes its success to the unstinted cooperation among parents, teachers, students and the school management. Ms Nitu Das, Administrator of the school opines that such a bonding is essential if the school aims to go beyond simply churning out success stories in examinations. The Director of the school, Mr.Narayan Deka, in a short interview, asserted that it would be the constant effort of the school to endow its students with sensitivity and empathy that enable them to reach out to the world in effectual service and untold creativity. He explained that the aim of the school is not to produce 'result-making machines' but to create sensitive individuals capable of contributing to the betterment of the self and of the community. This is probably what makes TCSG different!

uckland House School is named after Lord Auckland, the then Governor-General of India. This school is one of the oldest schools in Shimla. The project for starting a school to provide sound education to girls on Christian principles was initiated by the Rev. J. B.d' Aquilar in 1864. On the persuasion of Mrs, Cotton, the wife of Bishop Cotton, it was founded in Shimla in the spring of 1866 at Holly Lodge on Jakhu. In 1868 the Auckland House estate was bought and the school shifted here, in its present building, on the 6" of November, 1869.




